Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to the Sri Sai Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 21 seats in 04PG courses, namely (i)Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant -06 seats (ii) Agad Tantra -06 seats (iii) Shalakya Tantra -03 seats and (iv) Ras Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-06 seats for the academic session 2019-20 and denial of permission for conducting 03 PG courses i.e. (i) Rachana Sharir (ii) Prasuti Tantra & Sti Roga (iii) Shalya Tantra for the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order F.No.R.17011/203/2014-EP(IM-1) dated 14.08.2014 related to admission matter for a period not exceeding 5 years from the academic session 2014-15 to 2018-19 intimating that the college shall maintain all the Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as per extant regulations *in toto* during the permission period (2014-15 to 2018-19) and Ministry's letter of Permission F.No.R.13011/35/2013-EP(IM-1) & F.No.R.14011/22/2013-EP(IM-1) dated 10.10.2014 related to increase admission capacity from 75 to 100 seats in existing UG (BAMS) Course, increase in intake capacity from 04 to 06 seats in existing 02 PG Courses (i) Prasuti Tantra & Sti Roga and (ii) Shalya Tantra in each course and to start new 05 PG courses, namely (i) Shalakya Tantra -03 seats (ii) Rasashastra evum Bhaishajya Kalpna- 06 seats (iii) Agad Tantra -06 seats (iv) Rachna Sharir- 06 seats and (v) Maulik Sddhant- 06 seats from academic session 2014-15 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 27-28.03.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 01.07.2019 to present the case.

3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda colleges and attached Hospitals

and Post graduate Ayurveda Medical Education) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made there under and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and it is found that the college is not fulfilling all the norms of notified Regulations for granting permission for a period of five years (100% criteria). However, the said college is fulfilling all the norms for granting conditional permission (permission for a period of one year) for UG (BAMS) course and 04 PG Courses for the academic year 2019-20. They are, however, not fulfilling the criteria for grant of permission for 03 PG courses.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government **to grant Conditional Permission to Sri Sai Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh for conducting 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 21 seats in 04 PG courses**, namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant -06 seats (ii) Agad Tantra -06 seats (iii) Shalakya Tantra -03 seats and (iv) Ras Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana -06 seats **for the academic session 2019-20 and denial of permission for conducting 03 PG courses i.e. (i) Rachana Sharir (ii) Prasuti Tantra & Sti Roga (iii) Shalya Tantra due to non-availability of required number of Teaching staff and Higher Faculty as per IMCC PG Ayurveda regulation, 2016, for the academic session 2019-20** under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to following conditions:

- i. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- ii. The colleges shall submit undertaking in the form of Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/Hospital Clinical Staff/Consultant in concerned State Boards/Council where the college/hospital is located or Central Registration of the CCIM by 31st December, 2019 as per the decisions conveyed vide letters 22.03.2019 & 22.04.2019 by CCIM and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant/denial of permission for the academic year 2020-21.

5. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate and 15% of post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats and 21 PG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted there under.**

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made there under.

7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.

8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:


- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*; and
- (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.

9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.

10. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
